2011 Armidale Show Youth Show:

Conditions of entry

1. All heifers to be owned and registered in the name of the exhibitors
 2. Age of exhibitor must be between 8 and of 25 years of age as of the 4th March 2011
 3. All cattle are to be registered with a society.
 4. Cattle age limits (age as of 1st March 2011)
 - All heifers must be over 8 months and under 20 months and must be weaned
 - All steers must be milk tooth – Steers can be crossbred. (Steer classes will be decided on close of entries)
 5. NO bulls will be judged on Friday night.
 6. NOSE CLIPS OR RINGS ARE COMPULSORY
 7. Bulls under 20 months and young cows can be used in the Paraders competition
 8. All cattle must have a legible tattoo in accordance with a society.
 9. All cattle MUST have an NLIS Device.
 10. Classes for cattle and competitors will be determined after entries close.
 11. Appropriate dress must be worn at all times. No thongs or joggers allowed while working with the cattle.
 12. No alcohol to be consumed by persons under 18 at any time.
 13. Exhibitors must supply their own equipment and feed.
 14. No dogs to be allowed on the grounds. If dogs are found they will be IMPOUNDED.
 15. SOME Bedding for the cattle will be supplied.
 16. Health status of all exhibits must confirm to the district veterinary officer's requirements and documents of full status must be available on demand.
- ALL MUST BE FREE OF BRUCELLOSIS, TUBERCULOSIS AND JOHNES FREE HERD.**
17. All exhibits must have an acceptable temperament, be broken to lead and an animal can be disqualified by the committee, if it doesn't meet an acceptable standard.
 18. Schools/Colleges are eligible to participate
 19. All school competitors must be accompanied by a teacher, parent or guardian.
 20. Disruptive and unacceptable behaviour from exhibitors and students will not be tolerated. Unacceptable behaviour may lead to disqualification from the competition.
 21. ALL EXHIBITORS ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT MUST HAVE CURRENT CERTIFICATE FROM A REGISTERED ELECTRICIAN AS REQUIRED BY LAW
 22. There will be NO SMOKING in the cattle sheds, toilets, eating **and sleeping** areas.
 23. ALL COMPETITORS ENTER AT THEIR OWN RISK. INSURANCE AND PUBLIC LIABILITY IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR.
 24. ALL PROTESTS TO BE LODGED WITHIN 1 HOUR OF THE CLASS FINISHING, ACCOMPAINED WITH \$50.
 25. CLOSING DATE, 18th February 2011, NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Conditions:

1. Entry fee \$10 per animal and \$5 per animal for school entries (includes some bedding and breast plate) entries close 18th February 2011 with Colin Rex, ABRI, UNE ARMIDALE NSW 2351.
2. Exhibits to be registered in respective breed society herd book.
3. Stud grooms are to wear the approved breed uniform.
4. All ages to be taken from the 1st March 2011. Calves at foot to be less than nine months.
5. All male cattle over 12 months must have a nose ring. All females and males under 12 months to be paraded with a nose dog.
6. Neck straps are compulsory whenever cattle are in the stall.
7. Exhibits can only compete in one general class. Calves less than twelve months exhibited as a calf at foot cannot be exhibited in the under twelve month's class.
8. Steward reserve the right to alter classes if insufficient cattle are entered.
9. Johnes disease declarations by exhibitors/exhibitors agent form to be used. Cattle will be stalled in accordance with Herd Status.
10. Ribbons will be awarded to third place at the discretion of the judge.
11. Only cattle paraded in general classes may be entered in the group classes.
12. Appeal against a judges decision shall be in writing, submitted within one hour of the judges decision, and accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which shall be forfeited to the Society if the Committee considers the appeal to be frivolous. The appeal will be considered and decided by the Committee appointed for the purpose, as soon as circumstances permit. Should any exhibit to which a prize has been awarded be disqualified, the next on the list does not necessarily obtain the prize. The committee will decide.

NB – All cattle must be fitted with NLIS tag. All persons handling livestock must complete appropriate documentation and obtain wristband. Johnes declaration must accompany entry form or entry will be rejected
