Please read General Conditions and Regulations for Pavilion Exhibits

1. Please refer to Pavilion Section Conditions for details of Entry Conditions, Entry Closing Dates and times when exhibits may be delivered to the Pavilion.
2. Entry fees: \$1 per entry.
3. All exhibits must have name of exhibitor and a contact number fastened securely on the back.
4. Exhibit numbers, section and class numbers must be securely attached to exhibits.
5. Items for sale should have the price clearly marked and neatly fixed to the front of the work. Exhibitors name is not to be displayed on the front of the work. Selling commission is 20%.
6. Exhibits must be original work, not copied and the sole effort of the exhibitor. All works entered to have been executed during the past 12 months.
7. Exhibits mounted or framed must have secure means of hanging or will not be accepted.
8. Exhibitors should enter in their current age group.
9. All care will be taken with exhibits but no responsibility or liability will be accepted for loss, damage or theft.
10. All works to be collected from the Main Pavilion on Sunday 4th March 2012 between 9am and 12 noon.
