### **CONDITIONS**

*Please read General Conditions and Regulations for Pavilion Exhibits*

1. Entries for all Pavilion Exhibits are to be made on the Official Entry Forms and lodged with the Show Secretary by the closing date of **Wednesday February 22nd, 2012**, accompanied by the appropriate entry fees.  
Entries may be lodged online at the website [www.armidaleshow.com.au](http://www.armidaleshow.com.au) or forms may be completed and sent to The Secretary, PO Box 86, Armidale, or delivered to the Secretary's Office at the Armidale Showground no later than **Wednesday February 22nd, 2012**.
2. **Exhibits** are to be delivered to section Stewards in the Main Pavilion on Wednesday 29th February between 2.00pm and 6.00pm or on Thursday 1st March, between the hours of 7.30am and 9.00am. Class tickets must be securely attached. NO Exhibits will be accepted after 9.00am on Thursday.
3. Entry Forms and Exhibits for all sections with perishable items (Flowers, Fruit/Vegetable/Farm Produce and Cookery sections) will be accepted at the Pavilion on Wednesday 29th February between 2.00pm and 6.00pm, and between 7.30am and 9.00am on Thursday 1st March 2012. NO Exhibits will be accepted after 9.00am on Thursday.
4. The Committee has the right to refuse or accept any entry.
5. Class tickets will be available from the Secretary's office when entering Exhibits, and are to be collected from the Secretary's office before judging day.
6. Exhibits having previously won a prize at an Armidale Show are not eligible to enter.
7. Awarding of prizes will be at the discretion of the Judge.
8. Place cards and Champion sashes shall be awarded in all sections. Ribbons shall be awarded for all childrens classes.
9. Pavilion Exhibits may be collected only on **Sunday 4th March** between **9am and 12 midday**. Please make alternate arrangements if unable to collect at this time, as any exhibits not collected will be donated to charity.
10. All care is taken but the Society will not take any responsibility for the loss of or damage to any article, and accepts exhibits only under these conditions.
11. All point scores will be available on completion of Pavilion judging.
12. A **Junior** exhibitor is one aged under the age of eighteen (18) years.
13. A **Novice** is a person who has not won a prize in the particular Class & Section at an Armidale Show.
14. AV means Any Variety. AOV means Any Other Variety. AC means Any Colour. AOC means Any Other Colour.
15. **No posthumous** entries will be accepted for any pavilion exhibits.
