

## Section 15 ~ JAMS, PRESERVES and SPECIALITY PRODUCTS

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Please read General Conditions and Regulations for Pavilion Exhibits

1. Please refer to Pavilion Section Conditions for details of Entry Conditions, Entry Closing Dates and times when exhibits may be delivered to the Pavilion.
2. Entry fees: \$1 per entry.
3. Please Note: All jams, Conserves, Jellies, Marmalades, Pickles, chutneys are to be exhibited in 400g – 500g jars. All butters and sauces in appropriate sized containers, commercial lids must be painted silver or white.
4. Collection sets must be in identical jars or bottles and lids.
5. Please affix a small label (i.e. 25-50mm) to all entries (with collection sets identified) stating name of contents and date made.
6. Please ensure that all screw lids have been opened and THE INSIDE OF LIDS ARE CLEAN. Jars must be clean and polished when presented to the judge.
7. Jellies to be made from fresh fruit. Preserves to be in syrup or brine as appropriate, in Vacola No 31. Jars of preserves to be completely full. All other contents to be approx. 1cm from rim.
8. AV means any Any variety. AOV means Any Other Variety.
9. First and second prize winners will each receive a card. Sponsors have donated prizes in various categories for Champion exhibits.
10. Exhibit numbers, section and class numbers must be securely attached to exhibits.
11. Exhibits to be collected Sunday 4th March between 9 am and 12 noon.

#### Preserved Fruits, Jams, Jellies, Preserved Vegetables, Pickles and Sauces

##### Preserved Fruits:

1. Any variety of Stone or Berry fruits, Tomatoes, and/or Vegetables. Presented in Vacola No 31 jars.
  2. Collection sets must consist of: Fruit – 3 varieties  
Vegetables – 3 varieties.
- \* **Champion Sash for: Best Preserves Exhibit**

#### Jams and Conserves Jellies, Marmalades and Butters

3. Any fruit, (tomatoes are a fruit) including citrus.
4. Collection sets must consist of:  
Jams - 3 different Jams  
Jellies - 3 different Jellies  
Marmalades - 3 different Marmalades

- \* **Champion Sash for: Best Jam  
Best Jelly  
Best Marmalade  
Best Butter**

#### Pickles, Chutneys and Savoury Sauces

5. Any variety of pickles, relishes, chutneys based on vegetables or fruit
6. Sauces (e.g tomato, plum, mint etc)
7. Collection sets must consist of;  
Chutneys - 3 different varieties  
Relishes - 3 different varieties  
Sauces - 3 different varieties

- \* **Champion Sash awarded for: Best Chutney  
Best Relish  
Best Sauce**

#### Junior Section under 18

8. Any preserved fruit or vegetable
  9. Any jar jam
  10. Any pickles, chutney or relish
  11. Collection set of Jams – 3 different Jams
- \* **Champion Ribbons and Sponsor Awards**

#### Senior over 65's Section

12. Any variety of jam, marmalade, pickles, chutney or relish

#### Gift Box Selection

13. 6 Items in appropriate sized and labelled jars presented in a Gift Box or Basket. Lids may be covered and judging will be on presentation and appearance.

*Note: general condition 6 does not apply to this section.*

#### Dried Fruits and/or dried Vegetables

14. Dried Fruit must be not less than 250g
15. Dried Vegetables not less than 150g

#### Crystallised and Glace Fruits and/or Peels

16. Any variety of Crystallised Fruits or Glace Fruits and Peels not less than 300g

#### Special Section

17. Locally produced products non commercial: Pasta, Olives, Coffee, chilli, Muesli, nuts (sweet or savoury), spice mixes etc not less than 300g, please clear glass jars or bottles.
