1. **Please refer to Pavilion Section Conditions for details of Entry Conditions, Entry Closing Dates and times when exhibits may be delivered to the Pavilion.**
2. Entry fees: \$1 per entry.
3. Place cards – 1st and 2nd Place in each class; Champion Ribbon; Ribbons for children's classes under 18 years of age.
4. Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor, not previously worn and crafted within the last 12 months.
5. Exhibit numbers, section and class numbers must be securely attached to exhibits.
6. Exhibits to be collected Sunday 4th March between 8.00 am and 11.00am.

### **SPINNING**

1. 25 g Hank of Fine Handspun Wool suitable for Babywear
2. 50 g Hank of Handspun Wool equivalent to 5 ply – indicate intended use
3. 50 g Hank of Handspun Wool suitable for Sportswear or Rugmaking (equivalent to 8 ply) – entrant should label appropriately
4. 25 g Hank of Handspun Novelty Yarn - indicate intended use
5. 25 g Hank Fancy Plied handspun Yarn – indicate intended use
6. 25 g Hank of Handspun Yarn, other than sheep wool – indicate intended use

### **WEAVING**

7. Handwoven length of Fabric not less than 1 metre in length – indicate intended use
8. Handwoven Garment
9. Handwoven Article e.g. Table Mats, Cushions, Rugs, etc.

### **NOVICE SECTION**

10. 50 g Hank of Handspun Wool suitable for Sportswear
11. Article made from Handspun Wool – any technique
12. Woven article

### **JUNIOR SECTION (Aged Under 18)**

13. 25 g Hank of Handspun Wool suitable for Sportswear
14. Article made from Handspun Wool – any technique
15. Woven Article

### **FELTED SECTION (School Students)**

16. Felted Article (Pots, Cushions, Bags, etc)
17. Felted Garment (Vest, Scarf etc.)

### **DYE SECTION**

18. Collection of 4 or more Vegetable-dyed fibres – 10 g Hank each. Note source dye and mordant used
19. Collection of 4 or more Hanks of fibre using Commercial dye - 10 g Hank each. Note source dye
20. Hand-dyed article using Commercial Dyes – based on appropriate use of colour for article - note source dye
21. Hand-dyed article using Vegetable Dyes – based on appropriate use of colour for article – note source dye and mordant used

### **OPEN SECTION**

22. Article made from Handspun
23. Garment made from Handspun
24. Felted Article
25. Felted Garment
26. Any Article, any method – combination handspun/commercial yarns
